COURSE FEES

BURSARY FUNDS

We may be able to help you towards costs for some part-time courses if you're on a low income – annual household income less than £20,000.

CHILDCARE

Get in touch with us if you need to arrange childcare - we may be able to help with costs.

REFUNDS AND CANCELLATION POLICY

In the unlikely event that your course is cancelled, we will refund your fees. However, if you choose to cancel or withdraw from your course, full fees are payable. If you've already paid, you will not be entitled to a refund unless there are extenuating circumstances.

ADVANCED LEARNER LOAN

We can help you with your fees via our loan system. Similar to the Student Loans Company in Higher Education, repayments don't start until you're earning more than £21,000. The loans aren't means tested, but you will need to have been living in the UK for three years. You'll be entitled to the loan if you are:

1. 24 years or older at the start of your course and studying a Level 3 qualification or above, or
2. Between 19 and 24 years old, studying at Level 3 or above, having previously studied at Level 3


I wanted to give some very positive feedback from the recent lambing course.

ARE APPRENTICESHIPS FOR ME?

WHAT TYPES OF APPRENTICESHIPS ARE AVAILABLE?

There are several different types to choose from:

Intermediate Apprenticeship (Level 2)

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- You'll need to be in full-time employment for a minimum of 30 hours each week. Plus, you'll need to ensure that you have the chance to attend college during work hours as part of your paid employment.
- You will ideally have achieved GCSEs grades A-E or equivalent**. If you have an equivalent qualification, we will also take this into consideration, along with any industry experience that you may have.
- You'll need to attend an interview and complete an initial assessment. This is to help us understand what level you are currently working at, and to make sure that we arrange the right level programme to suit your individual needs.

* This rate may change on a yearly basis. Check www.gov.uk/national-minimum-wage-rates

** This will be different for Veterinary Nurses who will need 5 GCSEs at grades A-C. This must include English Language, Maths and Science, or alternatively an equivalent Level 2 or higher.

If you're 16-18 or over 19 in your first apprenticeship year, the minimum apprenticeship wage is £3.50* an hour. If you're considering taking on an apprentice within your organisation, here are some further details to guide you. Apprenticeships are an excellent opportunity for you to bring new enthusiasm and skills into your organisation. Aged 16 or over, apprentices are able to combine working for you at the same time as developing their skills and knowledge by studying for a work-based qualification. This could be from GCSE level, right through to degree level. During the apprenticeship, your apprentice will need to work with experienced staff and have the opportunity to learn job-specific skills. Apprentices can either be currently working as an employee or new to your organisation.

Lasting from 1-4 years, depending on the level of qualification your apprentice is studying, you'll need to pay your apprentice the apprenticeship minimum wage while they are on placement with you. For more details visit: <https://www.gov.uk/national-minimum-wage-rates>

Hiring an apprentice is an easy process:

1. Firstly, choose an apprenticeship standard or framework that fits in with your industry and at the appropriate job level. Learn more by visiting <https://findapprenticeshiptraining.sfa.bis.gov.uk/>

INTRODUCING THE APPRENTICE LEVY FUNDING

In Spring 2017, the way the government funds apprenticeships in England changed. Some employers are now required to contribute to a new apprenticeship levy, and there will be changes to the funding for apprenticeship training for all employers. If you're an employer operating in the UK, with a PAYE bill over £3 million each year, you'll be required to invest in apprenticeships.

Read on for details of how the apprenticeship levy works. This guidance is for all employers operating in the UK, regardless of whether you pay the apprenticeship levy or not. The reforms include giving employers the opportunity to add to the new apprenticeship standards already available:

If your apprentice started before the 1st May 2017, the levy will not affect the way you fund training for apprentices. You'll need to carry on funding training for these apprentices under the terms and conditions that were in place at the time when the apprenticeship started.

TO ACCESS YOUR LEVY MONEY USING THE APPRENTICESHIP SERVICE:

If your business has declared a levy to the HMRC, you'll have access to funding for apprenticeships via a new online apprenticeship service account called the Apprenticeship Service. You'll have 24 months to spend what you've paid in. In looking to find the best way for your business to invest this funding, the government is looking for employers to add value to your workforce through your investment. This could be through competition for the best talent, dealing with an ageing workforce or finding ways to keep and train good team members. When you register, make sure you have the following information:

IF YOU DON'T PAY THE LEVY

You won't need to use the apprenticeship service to pay for apprenticeship training and assessment until at least 2018. You'll be advised by the government when to start using the apprenticeship service to pay for apprenticeship training.

From the new funding system which launches in May 2017, you can now choose which training you'd like your apprentices to receive and where. These can be found using the registers available on the apprenticeship service. Have a look at the National Apprenticeship Service <https://www.gov.uk/take-on-an-apprentice>

If you have more than 49 employees, you'll be asked by the government to make a 10% contribution to the cost of your training. The government will pay the rest (90%), up to the maximum amount of government funding available for that apprenticeship. You'll be asked to pay this directly to us. As both you and the government make a payment, this is called 'co-investment'.

For every individual apprenticeship framework and standard, each will have a funding band. The top of the funding band will be the maximum that the Government will be prepared to 'co-invest'.

FIND OUT ABOUT ADDITIONAL FUNDING

If you have less than 49 employees, the Government will pay 100% of your funding if you take on a 16-18 year old. Care leavers aged 19-24 and young people with an education, health and care plan will also included on this basis.

INCENTIVE PAYMENTS

These are designed to encourage organisations to bring young people into the job market. The Government will pay you £1,000 plus a further £1,000 to the training provider if you take on a 16-18 year old apprentice or disadvantaged young people - 19-24 year olds leaving care or who have a education, health and care plan.





WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

A great chance for your daughter or son to earn while they learn. The land-based sector is thriving and apprenticeships are available in a wide variety of industries. Apprenticeships take between 1 and 4 years to complete.

WHAT BENEFITS DO THEY OFFER?

By taking on an apprenticeship, students will be able to earn a salary and paid holiday while still training. Learning at their own pace and with the support of their own mentor. They'll be safe in the knowledge that they'll be learning skills that employers want. There are also great opportunities for progression to be had – both in further studies or progressing further up the career ladder. This also means that students have a better future earning potential. Students completing a higher apprenticeship have the chance to earn a further £150,000 over their lifetime.

WHAT AGE CAN MY CHILD LEAVE SCHOOL?

The school leaving age has now been changed by the Government. In England, children born after the 1st September 1997 must stay in some form of education or training until after their 18th birthday. This doesn't limit students to staying at school. Opportunities are available either:

- studying full-time at school, college or with a training organisation
- working full-time or volunteering while studying or training part-time
- taking on an apprenticeship or traineeship






