• For Plumpton College:

HORTICULTURE

Are you interested in maintaining, designing or building gardens? Would you like to work in glasshouses? Do you want to experience the use of horticultural machinery or design and build paving and fencing? The horticulture taster course will allow you to find out more about these subjects and the job prospects in the very varied world of horticulture. This is an exciting industry where there are jobs in the UK and elsewhere in the world and many of our students start their own business.



ENVIRONMENTAL & CONSERVATION

Did you know that we have a large estate just waiting for you to explore? Woods, streams, farmland and downland, which are habitats for most of the wildlife in Sussex. Come and see for yourself what a career as a ranger might involve and learn some of the traditional countryside skills.



GAME & WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

In the woods on our estate you will get a chance to see how birds are reared and cared for. You will be shown the practical skills you will need to learn to take advantage of the opportunities there are for you in a career in game keeping and estate work. The day will include the preparation of traps for pests and predators.



FISHERY MANAGEMENT

Do you enjoy fishing? If so why not turn your hobby into a career. Come and try the fishery course taster day and see the sorts of jobs that are available in fishing and fishery management. You will get an introduction into fly fishing and coarse fishing which may involve learning how to tie a fly and maybe have a go at fly casting. Learn about habitat creation and see the brown trout streams on the College estate. Depending on the time of year you may get an opportunity to go fishing on one of the College lakes.



AGRICULTURAL MACHINERY

Do you like the idea of working with tractors, agricultural or plant machinery? Why not get some first hand experience? Test your skills on our machinery. Find out if you have got what it takes for a career in agricultural or plant machinery and what to do next.


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WINE
