80 years ago, people around the world celebrated the end of a long and difficult war, a moment that brought hope, healing, and the promise of a better future.

We invite you to join us on this special day to pay tribute to those who fought for our freedom and to celebrate the lasting spirit of unity and hope.



### Plumpton College 1939-1945

Courses were paused during the Second World War, and the school was used for short courses to over 2,000 entrants to the Women's Land Army, where they were trained for farm work in different parts of the country.

Much of Wales Farm was used for food production, which included growing mangold (a type of fodder for livestock), and the Moat Barn area became one of the County War Agricultural Committee's machinery depots.







These vacancies are open for current and past students of Plumpton College as well as non students.


