| Week Commencing 1 June 2020 | Virtual tour of the workshop – "Welcome to your Plumpton College motor vehicle course, here is some of the equipment you can expect to use" | 1 week |
| Week Commencing 15 June 2020 | "Say what you see" video – a video "walk around" where the students list as many systems/components as they can. Followed up by a. Record your own video walking around and inside your car, explaining what items you would check during routine maintenance and where you would check or top up the fluid levels (routine maintenance unit evidence) b. 2 & 3 could perhaps be blended into one – they watch our video then go off and create their own | 1 week |
| Week Commencing 22 June 2020 | Health & safety in the workshop – we film a video of the workshop with common hazards "staged" and the students have to identify as many as they can (health & safety unit evidence) | 1 week |
| Week Commencing 29 June 2020 | Spot-a-lemon video guide of simple things to look out for when buying a car | 1 week |
| Week Commencing 6 July 2020 | 2 & 3 are blended - List as many garages as you can near where you live. What services do they offer? Ie, wheel alignment, MOT testing, air conditioning etc. Do they specialise in anything? Ie classic car restoration, BMW specialist etc | 1 week |
