Terms & Conditions of Entry

• Disclaimer of liability.

Plumpton College and the show organisers shall not be liable for any claim for damage or loss to competitor, their helpers, the general public, animals, vehicles and equipment or any other item however caused. It is a condition of entry that all attending competitors in the event will have their own public liability insurance and that each participant will indemnify the organisers against any accident, incident damage or loss however caused.

• The judge's decision is final.

However, any serious objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the cause of the dispute and lodged with the secretary with a deposit of £20, refundable if the objection is withheld.

- Health and safety.
- The organisers have taken responsibility and precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For the measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions of the organisers and their officials.
- The organisers reserve the right to:

Refuse entry without stating a reason

Alter the order or composition of the schedule

Demand any person shall leave the showground

Postpone or cancel the show due to any unforeseen circumstances

- No horse or pony under four years of age may be ridden in any class at the show.
- When mounted, all riders must wear a hat to current BSI standard and secured correctly.
- Misuse of whips and spurs will result in disqualification and being asked to leave the showground
- No entries will be refunded unless accompanied by doctors or veterinary certificate.
- Competitors entering more than one class are responsible for getting to the correct ring for the start of each class and will only be allowed in at the judge's discretion.
- Competitors must respect the boundaries of the show site. Horses must proceed at walk in the vicinity of the rings. Failure you do so will result to being asked to leave the showground
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times and small children must be kept under control
- It is advised that all mares in season and kickers should wear a red ribbon in the tail

Please leave the car park and horsebox area tidy.
