2ft 3 - 2ft 6 (60-70cm) – One round that is timed from start to finish.

Class 13- Novice **

2ft 6 (70-75cm) - Open to all.
Single Phase

Class 14 - Intermediate **

2ft 9 - 3ft (80-90cm) – Open to all.
Single Phase

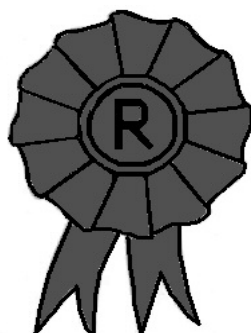

Ring 5 - Ridden Showing

09.00 start. Rosettes from 1st-6th place.

£8 per class

Class 15– 9.00 Ridden Condition and Turn Out **

Open to all

Class 16– 10.00 Ridden M and M (small breed) **

Open to Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Section A & B

Class 17 - 10.45 Ridden M and M (large breed) **

Open to Welsh Section C & D, New Forrest, Connemara, Dales, Fells and Highlands

Class 18– 11.30 Ridden Cob **

Open to all traditional and non traditional Cobs

Class 19– 12.30 Ridden Coloured **

Open to all

Class 20 – 13.30 Ridden Thoroughbred **

(Open to all registered Thoroughbreds. May or may not have previously raced.)

Class 21 - 14.30 Ridden Veteran **

Horses/Ponies aged 18 years and over.

3.30 Ridden Championship

Open to all Ridden Competitors placed 1st in their class.

Ring 6 - In-Hand Showing

9am start. Rosette's 1st to 6th place

Class 23 - 9.45- In-Hand Prettiest Mare **

Class 24– 10.30- In-Hand Young Handlers (under the age of 16 years)

Class 25-11.15- In-Hand Handsomest Gelding **

Class 26– 12.00– In-Hand Cute and Cuddly

Ring 6 Ridden Showing

Class 27 - 12.45- Lead Rein ** (Riders 10 years and under) Riders can not entered into another class off the lead rein.

Class 28 - 13.30- First Ridden ** Riders must be off the lead rein. No cantering as a ride. Cantering is optional in the individual show.

Class 29 - 14.15 - Novice Ridden ** (Open to combination of horse and rider not to have been placed 1st-3rd in any showing classes in 2016)

Winners from classes 27—29 will qualify for the Ridden Championship in Ring 5 at 3.30

**** = Sunshine Tour Qualifier**

Show Rules

1. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY.** The organisers or landowners shall not be liable for any claim for damage or loss to competitors, their helpers, general public, animals, vehicles and equipment or any other item however caused. It is a condition of entry that all attending/competing in the event will have their own public liability insurance and that each participant will identify the organisers against any accident or loss however caused.
2. The judges decision is final. However, any serious objections must be made in writing within 15 minutes of the cause of dispute and lodged with the secretary with a deposit of £30, refundable if the objection is upheld.
3. **HEALTH AND SAFETY.** The organisers have taken responsible precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For the measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and their officials.
4. The organisers reserve the right to-
 - A - Refuse any entry without stating a reason.
 - B - Alter the order of composition of the schedule.
 - C - Demand any person shall leave the showground.
 - D - Postpone or cancel the show due to unforeseen circumstances.
5. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years old may be ridden in any class at the show.
6. When mounted, all riders must wear a hard hats correctly secured to current BSI standard.
7. Misuse of whips and spurs will result in disqualification and being asked to leave the show ground.
8. Entries to all classes will be limited; no entries will be refunded unless accompanied by a doctors or veterinary note.
9. Competitors entering more than one class are responsible for getting to the correct ring for the start of the class, and will only be allowed in at the judge's discretion.
10. Competitors must respect the boundaries of the show site. Horses must proceed at walk in the vicinity of the rings. Failure to do so will result in being asked to leave the showground.
11. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and small children kept under control.
12. It is advised that mares in season and kickers should wear a red ribbon on their tail.
13. Please leave the car park and horsebox area tidy and put your litter in the nearest bin or home with you.

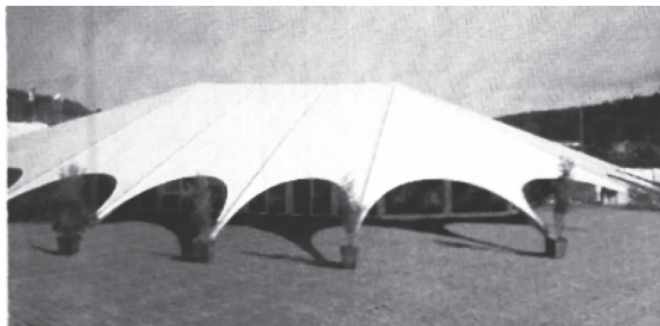

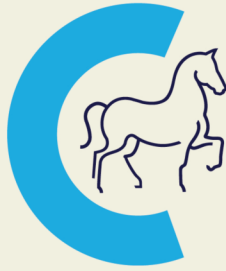
